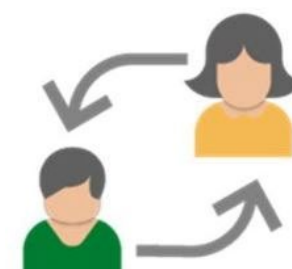
Academic Services
