1. Give details of the applicant's current circumstances. This includes ties to family, community, employment and economic circumstances.

- Explain your family, community, or employment ties to your home country (or country of residence)
- If a similar course is available in your home country (or country of residence), please provide your reasons for not studying there.
- Provide information about your financial circumstances.

2. Explain why the applicant wishes to study this course in Australia with this education provider. This must also explain their understanding of the requirements of the intended course and studying and living in Australia.

- Provide information about your previous study and qualifications.
- Explain why you wish to study this course in Australia. Include any research you have undertaken about studying in Australia.
- Explain why you wish to study this course at MIT and include any research you have undertaken.
- Explain your knowledge of living in Australia and your living arrangements.
